PRCUA NATIONAL BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

RULES OF PLAY as of 2017

- 1. All games will be played in 20 minute running clock halves, with regulation stop-clock for the final 2 minutes of last half.
- 2. Game time is forfeit time.
- 3. Overtime periods will be 3 minutes long. The final minute of the overtime period will be regulation stop-clock.
- 4. Two time-outs are allowed per half. They do not carry over to the second half or to overtime periods. An additional time-out will be granted for each overtime period.
- 5. A jump ball will be used to start the game. Thereafter, the alternate possession rule will be in effect.
- 6. Teams will be in the bonus free-throw situation on the 7th team foul.
- 7. Technical fouls will count towards a player's personal fouls.
- 8. In all other situations, official high school rules will be followed.
- 9. Team members must wear the same color jersey with numbers on the back.
- 10. Each team must supply a spotter to assist the official scorekeeper.
- 11. Final decisions will be made by the tournament committee.
- 12. The tournament format uses a "pre-tourney" round to split teams into divisions of play. First round competition will place losers into a "B" division double-elimination tournament, and winners into an "A" division double-elimination tournament.
- 13. Both division winners and runners up will receive awards. All-Stars and MVP's will be selected for both divisions.
- 14. All teams must be listed on the final roster.
- 15. Substitutions of new players will not be allowed after the start of the tournament.
- 16. Each player may only sign one roster.
- 17. All tournament participants must sign a Waiver of Liability prior to the start of the tournament.
